City Sights provides a service to aid blind and partially sighted people to access Exeter City Centre with the help of a trained volunteer as their guide.

Who Can Use It?

It is available to anybody aged 16 and over with a sight impairment. Both residents and visitors to Exeter will be able to use the service.

What sort of things can I do?

It's up to you! There are all sorts of things the service could be used for, such as:

- Shopping
- Accessing arts and entertainment facilities
- Visiting attractions
- Assistance with paperwork

We will endeavour to try and meet your needs, so let us know what you'd like to do and we'll try to make it happen.

Our Volunteers

The guides working on City Sights are all volunteers who are fully trained to ensure awareness and the needs of blind and visually impaired people are met. To ensure your utmost safety all of our volunteers are also subject to an enhanced criminal record bureau check. Our guides vary in age ranges and are both ladies and gentlemen.

How much does it cost?

It costs £2 per hour to use one of our guides, with payment being made either at the ECTA office on the day or by invoice at the end of the month.

Do I need to book?
