What is Exeter Ring & Ride?

People who are unable to use regular buses can travel on our wheelchair accessible minibus from their homes into Exeter city centre, to local supermarkets and on lunches and excursions.

Who Can Use it?

Ring & Ride is for anyone who is having problems using the ordinary bus, perhaps because the stop is too far away to walk, or because the bus steps are too steep. Our bus is easy access, especially for walking frame and wheelchair users.

Where Will the Bus Stop?

The driver will bring you into the city centre and will link with Exeter Shopmobility for wheelchairs or scooters. For at least one week of every month the bus takes passengers to local supermarkets. The bus will collect you where it leaves you, after a stop of about two hours. We also do a number of lunches and excursions to local events and places of interest.

How do I use Ring & Ride?

Telephone us, between 10am and 4pm, up to a week before and not later than the previous working day to book your seat.

All Part of the Service!

Our driver will be happy to help load your shopping onto the bus and assist in carrying your bags to your front door, all you need to do is ask.

How Much Will it Cost?

The fare for a single or return journey is £3.50. (£3.70 on Fridays from the Broadclyst and Cranbrook area). You may bring a companion and they pay the same amount. You pay our driver on boarding the bus. There is no additional charge if you want to travel on the bus in a wheelchair.

Private Hire

The Ring & Ride bus is available for use by special needs groups, voluntary organisations and youth groups in the Exeter area during evenings and weekends at reasonable rates.
